2.2.1. Proposal Phase (2013-2014)

4.2.3. Tackle Geopolitical and Security Risks

Strengthen diplomatic efforts and dialogue mechanisms on geopolitical issues, advocating for and promoting regional peace and stability. This could include mediation by international institutions, political dialogues, and conflict prevention. Enhance security cooperation among regions, including intelligence sharing, security risk assessments, and combating transnational crime. Strengthening security cooperation can reduce the impact of security risks on the initiative.

4.2.4. Enhance Environmental Protection and Sustainable Development

Develop and promote green standards and environmental guidelines to ensure the environmental friendliness and sustainable development of initiative projects. This could include environmental impact assessments, resource management, and ecological restoration measures. Strengthen technology transfer and capacity building to support countries along the route in enhancing their capabilities in environmental protection and sustainable development. This can be achieved through technical cooperation projects, training programs, and sharing of experiences.

4.2.5. Strengthen Legal and Compliance Support

Enhance international legal cooperation and develop a consistent legal framework to ensure the compliance and legal protection of initiative projects in different countries. This can be achieved through signing bilateral or multilateral cooperation agreements, strengthening intellectual property protection, and promoting dispute resolution mechanisms. Provide relevant training and legal support to help countries along the route understand and comply with international and domestic laws, thereby reducing legal risks and disputes.

4.2.6. Enhance Public Participation and Transparency

Establish mechanisms for information disclosure and consultation to ensure the transparency of project information and provide opportunities for public participation. This can be achieved through establishing project websites, holding public seminars, and soliciting public opinions. Establish independent monitoring mechanisms, including government regulatory bodies, independent media, and non-governmental organizations, to oversee the implementation and outcomes of projects. Encourage the participation of social organizations and civil groups in project decision-making and supervision, providing diverse voices and opinions.

5. Conclusion

After analyzing the development, achievements, and challenges of the "Belt and Road" Initiative over its 10-year anniversary, we have reached the following key points and findings:

Firstly, over the past decade, the "Belt and Road" Initiative has achieved remarkable developmental successes.
